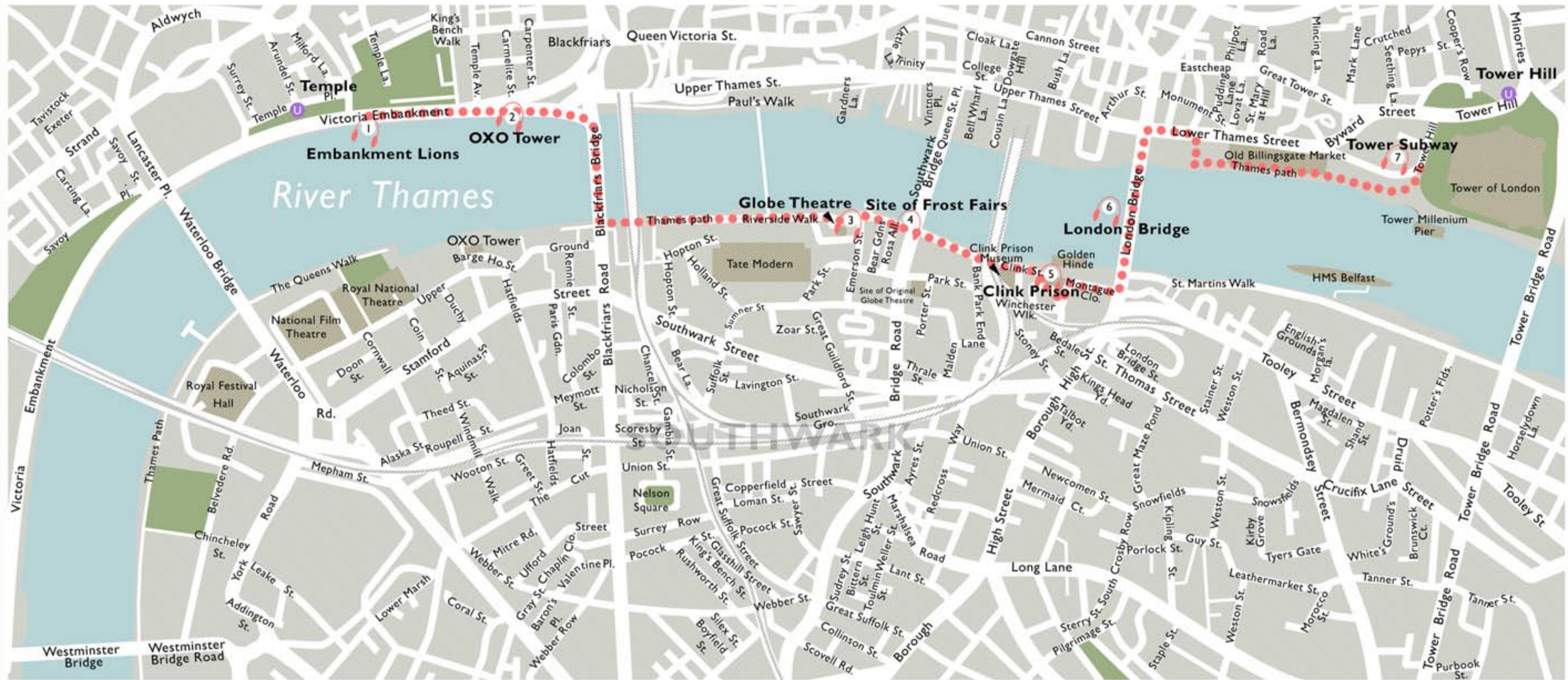


EBB AND FLOW - THE MIGHTY RIVER THAMES



LEGEND

Tour Path

Walk Length - 3km

Starting Point - Victoria Embankment

Nearest Underground - Temple (District, Circle Lines)

- 1 Embankment Lions
- 2 OXO Tower
- 3 Globe Theatre
- 4 Site of Frost Fairs
- 5 Clink Prison
- 6 London Bridge
- 7 Tower Subway

Ending Point - Tower of London

Nearest Underground - Tower Hill (District, Circle Lines)

Directions

Start at Victoria Embankment opposite Temple underground station. Lean over the stone wall by the river. Look down towards the water and then to your right 1

Turn left and walk along Victoria Embankment. Stop just beyond the two dragons by the side of the road and look to your right to the opposite side of the river 2

Keep walking along Victoria Embankment and turn right to cross over Blackfriars Bridge. Once across turn left and go down the steps on your left. At the bottom turn right and walk along the Thames Path with the river to your left. Stop outside the Globe Theatre which is just past the Tate Modern on your right 3

Continue along the Thames Path and go under Southwark Bridge. Stop by the furthest of the large stone tablets on your right 4

Continue out from under the bridge and along the path. When the path ends turn right by the Anchor pub and then left straight away. Stop by the entrance to the Clink Prison museum which will be directly in front of you 5

Continue along Clink Street past the museum. When you reach the Golden Hinde, turn right, then left at the first opportunity, left again and then right (At this point Southwark Cathedral should be on your right). Just before the arch that would take you under London Bridge, climb the steps on your left. At the top of the steps turn left to walk across the bridge. Stop when you get to the centre and look out across the river 6

Continue along the bridge. Just past the end, take the subway steps on your left. Walk all the way through the subway following the signs for the Tower of London. When you exit, turn right onto Lower Thames Street. About 50 metres along, turn right at the sign which points to 'Riverside Walk East'. At the river turn left and continue along the path, keeping the river on your right. When you reach the Tower Millenium Pier turn left and walk away from the river for about 20 metres. Stop at the circular brick construction with the Welcome Centre directly behind it 7
