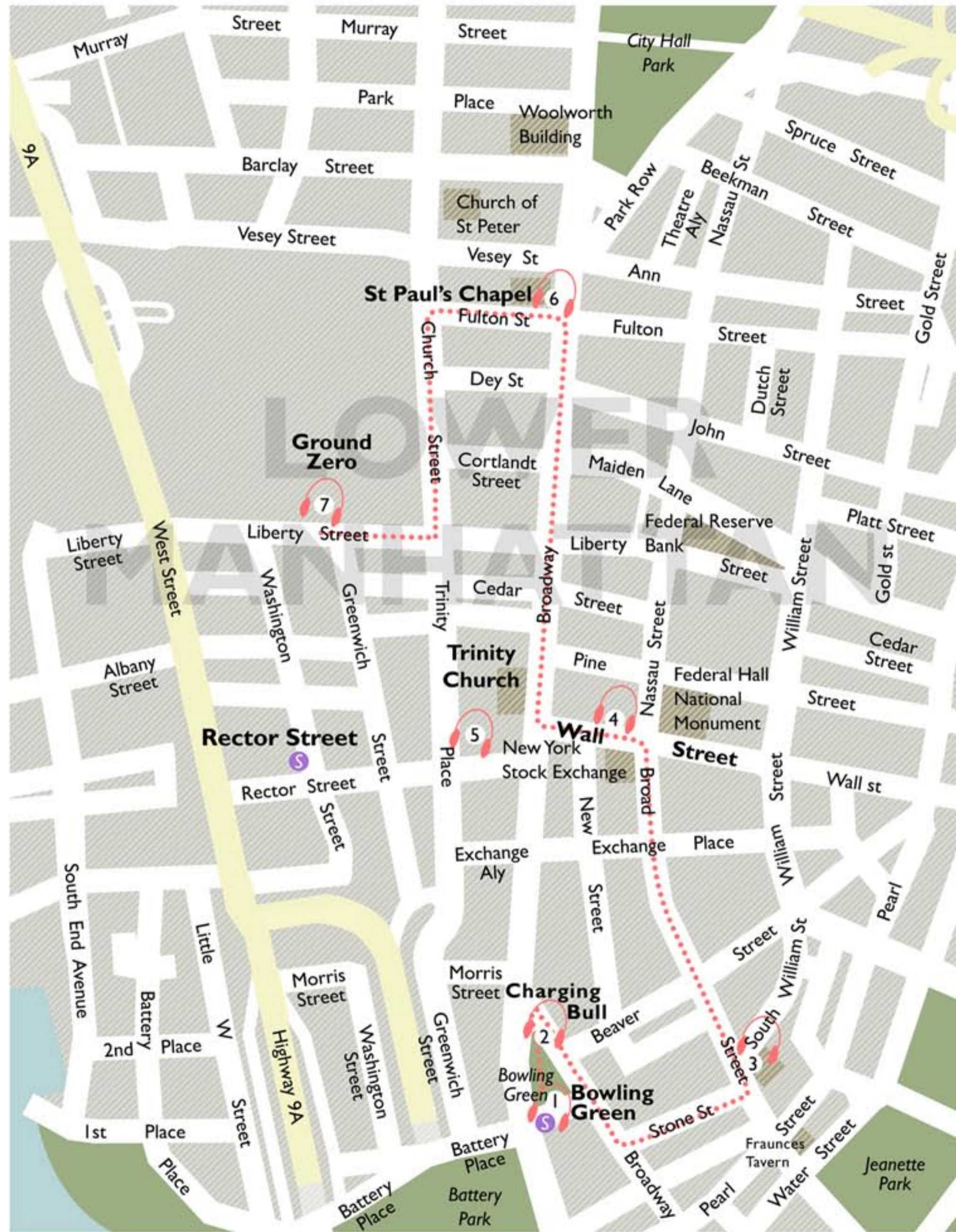

Walk Length - 2 km

Starting Point - Bowling Green - Beaver Street at Broadway

Nearest Subway - Bowling Green (Lines 4, 5,)

- 1 Bowling Green
- 2 Charging Bull
- 3 85 Broad Street
- 4 Wall Street
- 5 Trinity Church
- 6 St Paul's Chapel
- 7 Ground Zero

Ending Point - Ground Zero - Vesey Street at Church Street

Nearest Subway - Rector Street (Lines R,W)

Directions

Start at the centre of Bowling Green, facing the plaque at the south side of the fountain 1

Exit Bowling Green via the North gate and walk to the Bronze Bull which you will see directly in front of you 2

Walk back down Broadway, passing Bowling Green on your right. Turn left onto Stone street. At the end of the block cross the road and walk round to the right of 85 Broad Street which you will see directly in front of you. Stop when you get to the fence surrounding glass panels in the floor 3

Go back to the front of the building and turn right, walking along Broad Street until you get to the junction with Wall Street. Stop at the corner - the New York Stock Exchange will be on your left and the Federal Hall National Monument facing you 4

Turn left onto Wall Street. Go to the end of the road and go into the section of the churchyard to the left of Trinity Church. Stop by the grave topped with a white obelisk at the far left of the Churchyard 5a

Go into the Church (The museum with the duelling pistols is at the back left) and walk back out into the area of the churchyard on the opposite side. Look for a flat lying gravestone near Broadway marked 'Charlotte Temple' (There is a map of the Churchyard available inside the Church) 5b

Exit the Churchyard and turn left onto Broadway. Continue five blocks until you come to St Paul's Chapel which is just past Fulton Street on the left. Go into the Chapel 6

Turn right out of the Chapel and then right again onto Fulton Street. Turn left onto Church Street and then right onto Liberty Street, skirting round the construction site at Ground Zero. Stop at a point on Liberty Street where you have a good view of the site 7
